Bonaire Golf Club has a 6,000 ft<sup>2</sup> clubhouse with a 1/12 pitch galvanized insulated roof. We have two-5 ton ground source heat pumps (for cooling) and utilize the upper 4 feet of the building as the cold exchange chamber.

In the past, our air conditioners would not keep up with the demand at 28°C plus temperatures. We recently had your company apply SUPER THERM insulating ceramic coating to the entire roof. Since then, we lived through a 5-day heat wave of 34°C daytime and 16-24°C nighttime temperatures. We only used ONE air conditioner for the 8am to 9am and 5pm to 8pm time periods and both during the day. The building stayed well within our comfort range and much cooler than previous years.

We are saving the purchase of another air conditioner plus all its related energy and maintenance costs, plus we are using our existing two units less, and our building is more comfortable.
